AnzenOT operates as a cloud-based SaaS platform, meaning it doesn't require any on-premises installations or direct engagement with the customer's internal network infrastructure. This design benefits both AnzenOT and Armis customers by simplifying deployment, minimizing potential security exposures within the customer's operational technology (OT) environment, and reducing the IT overhead associated with integration and ongoing maintenance.

AnzenOT processes and analyzes data from Armis in real-time, without storing or hosting any sensitive network information:

This joint solution emphasizes immediate utility and security. AnzenOT focuses on live data processing and analysis of the information streamed from Armis, rather than persistent storage of sensitive network details. This collaborative design enhances overall data security by minimizing the risk of data breaches, as the combined intelligence is analyzed on the fly to generate critical risk assessments, ensuring that proprietary network configurations and asset details, initially gathered by Armis, are not retained by AnzenOT.
